1. Definition

- (2) "Computer" means a physical hardware system and/or a virtual hardware system made by certain virtualization technology on which the Licensed Product may operate without any modification thereto.

2. Term

- (1) You may terminate the license granted hereunder by notifying NEC in writing at least (1) one month prior to the desired termination date.
- (2) NEC may terminate the license granted hereunder at any time if you fail to comply with any terms or conditions of this Agreement.
- (3)Upon termination of the license, you must destroy the Licensed Product, and copies thereof, if any.

3. License

(1) You may install one (1) copy of the Licensed Product on your Computer(s) up to the Licensed Number set forth below. "Install" means making the Licensed Product operable on particular computer(s) (such as enabling to execute the Licensed Product on the computer by extraction of compressed files, saving executable files in external storage units, registering at registry of Operating System).
